## COST

**\$945**

**Camp Fee \$905:** Camp will consist of one 4-week session at the rate of \$905.00. Campers must register for the full session.

**Registration Fee \$40:** A \$40 non-refundable registration fee per camper is due with registration form.

## PLEASE NOTE:

Camp must have a minimum of 34 campers registered by April 29 to avoid camp cancellation. In the event camp is canceled, refunds will be issued minus the \$40 registration fee.
